THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 39.

Whereas I, Warren Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, am satisfied that the premises set out in the Schedule hereto have been used in a manner prejudicial to the interests of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 39 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, I hereby order that the premises set out in the Schedule hereto shall be closed and remain closed until further notice.

The premises commonly known as Paradise Cinema situate at Wright Street, Ayios Dhometios.

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

With reference to Notification No. 466 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 7th June, 1956, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein :—

All those areas of privately owned lands with everything standing thereon, comprising 1 donum and 2,400 sq. ft. or thereabouts, forming parts of plots Nos. 372, 305, 316, 306, 307, 310 and 315 of Block L, Dhali village, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Director of Water Development and dated the 3rd November, 1956.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands who objects to the acquisition is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Government is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my Office.
