THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

- 2. Her Majesty's Forces are hereby authorized to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest as may be necessary for security purposes.
- 2. The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

- 1. All vegetation in plots 84 and 51, Block C, Kato Varosha, within 10 feet of the track bounding the plots on their southern side, together with any fences preventing access to the plots from the track, and the hedge preventing access to plot 51 on its eastern side for a distance of 100 yards back from the track.
- 2. All vegetation in plot 30, Block C, Kato Varosha, within 10 feet of the track bounding the plot on its northern side, together with any fences preventing access to the plot from the track and all vegetation within 10 feet of the eastern and western boundaries of the plot for a distance of 100 yards back from the track.
- 3. All vegetation and fences in plots 31, 38, 45, 46 and 03, Block G, Ayia Zoni, within 10 feet of the track which continues Plutarchos Street in a south-westerly direction to meet the track forming the continuation of Tryphon Street.
