THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. ${ }^{1}$ ) 1956.

Order made under Regulation 38 (i).
I, the Commissioner of Limassol, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the above Regulations, do hereby order as follows:-
r. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Limassol District No. 3) Order, 1956.
2. The areas specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be protected areas for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the above Regulations.
3. No person shall enter the areas except with the permission of the Port Security Control Officer, Limassol.
4. No vessel of any kind shall tie up to the jetties specified unless authorized to do so in writing by the Coilector of Customs and Excise, Limassol, except in the event of genuine distress.

## Schedule.

(a) The installations and buildings comprising the Limassol Customs area and bounded by the protecting fence.
(b) The entire structures comprising :-
(i) The K.E.O. Factory Jetty ;
(ii) The Asbestos Company's Jetty ;
(iii) The Limassol Municipal Baths Jetty ;
(iv) The jetty opposite the Continental Hotel ;
(v) The jetty opposite the Palace Hotel ;
(vi) The jetty opposite the Roman Catholic Church ; as delineated on the plan signed by the Commissioner, Limassol, dated the 2nd November, 1956.
