NOTICE UNDER SECTION 11.

Notice is hereby given that in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11 of the Tobacco Laws, any leaf tobacco, other than fumigated tobacco, being tobacco cultivated prior to the year 1956, shall within twenty-one days from the 31st day of December, 1956, be transported to any of the Custom Houses at Famagusta, Larnaca, Limassol, Paphos or Kyrenia at the option of the grower or, with the permission of the Comptroller, to a tobacco warehouse.

THE IRRIGATION (PRIVATE WATER) ASSOCIATION LAWS, 1949 AND 1954.

In pursuance to the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Laws, 1949 and 1954, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Association of Agridhia (Platanidia), in the District of Limassol, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF AGRIDHIA (PLATANIDIA).

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Association of Agridhia (Pano Platanidia) Rules, 1956.

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Limassol;

“Committee” means the Committee of the Irrigation Association;

“Irrigation Association” means the Irrigation Association of Agridhia (Pano Platanidia);

“Law” means the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Laws, 1949 and 1954;

“List” means the list of the names and residences of the proprietors and of the extent of the interest of each proprietor in the water, as finally settled in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of the Law;

“Works” means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Association.

3. The present Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 22nd May, 1956. The election of each subsequent Committee shall take place in the manner herein-after provided every three years in the first week of the month of May and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of the expiration of the period of office of the previous Committee.

4.—(1) The Commissioner shall, not less than one month before the holding of the meeting as in rule 3 provided, cause a written notice thereof to be—

(a) published in a newspaper or newspapers; and

(b) posted in a conspicuous place in the town, village or quarter in which the water is situated.

(2) All expenses connected with the notices shall be paid for from the funds of the Irrigation Association.

5.—(1) The Commissioner shall preside at every meeting so convened and if any question is raised as to the right of a person to attend thereat or to vote, the Commissioner may there and then make such enquiry as he may deem requisite and declare whether such person has a right to attend or to vote or not and the decision so made shall be final; and an entry shall be made in the minutes of the meeting of any such question and of the decision thereon.
