REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 30 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 30 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Control of Mooring) (Paphos District) Order, 1956.

2. No vessel shall moor at any place in the Paphos District other than at Paphos, Limni or Latchi.

No. 1109.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment of the Estate Duty Law) Regulations, 1956.

2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations the sections of the Estate Duty Law specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be read and construed as if they were respectively amended in the manner shown in the second column of the said Schedule.

20	<p>Add the following new paragraph after paragraph (b) in sub-section (a) the comma at the end of paragraph (b) being replaced by a semi colon and the word "or" :—" (c) any person, other than a person referred to in paragraphs (a) or (b) of this sub-section dies from injuries received within three years of his death and which were, in the opinion of the Governor-in-Council, caused by terrorist activity :</p> <p>Provided that the Governor-in-Council is satisfied that such person had no connection with any unlawful association or terrorist activity."</p> <p>Add the following new sub-section after sub-section (2) :—</p> <p>" (3) For the purposes of paragraph (c) of sub-section (1) of this section :—</p> <p>' terrorist activity ' means any criminal activity which the Governor-in-Council is satisfied has taken place in the course of terrorist operations ;</p> <p>' unlawful association ' shall have the same meaning as in section 60 of the Criminal Code (Cap. 13)."</p>
