And whereas the Governor has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that only that part of the lands described in the Schedule hereto should be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of that part of the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE.

All those areas of privately owned lands, with everything standing thereon, situated at Ayios Loukas Quarter, Famagusta Town, comprising 142 donums, two evleks and 1,200 square feet or thereabouts, and including parts of plots Nos. 182, 30, 685, 54, 53, 51, 50, 49 and 55 and the whole of plots Nos. 34, 35, 36, 231 and 353 of Block C, more particularly defined as the areas coloured red and green on the plan marked "Improvement of Famagusta Port" and dated the 17th November, 1956, deposited in the office of the Commissioner of Famagusta.

The areas coloured green on the said plan shall form "road protecting strips" and shall not be ceded to the public road.

## Notice under Section 6.

With reference to the Notification No. 665 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 25th November, 1954, notice is hereby given that the following land is required for the undertaking of public utility mentioned therein:—
