THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.

ORDER MADER UNDER REGULATIONS 44 AND 45.

In exercise of the powers vested in His Excellency the Governor by Regulations 44 and 45 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 26th February, 1955, and Notification No. 6 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 5th January, 1956, I, Warren Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, do hereby give notice that in the interests of public order and safety and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the Community have taken possession with immediate effect of the land specified in the First Schedule hereto and of the furniture and chattels listed in the Second Schedule hereto until further notice.

2. The use of the said land by the Military Authorities for the requirements of the Military personnel and/or Internal Security Forces is hereby authorised.

3. The authority using the land in pursuance of this Order is to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of their occupation.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

All the privately owned property situated in Orta Keuy Village, Nicosia District, known as the "Gardenia Club", comprising land, buildings and all appurtenances thereto under plot Nos. 151, 152, 153, 157 and 158 of the Government Survey Plans Nos. XXI.29.E.2 and XXI.30.W.2, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Commissioner of Nicosia and dated the 15th November, 1956, a copy of which is deposited in his office in Nicosia.
