**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 14) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. Her Majesty's Forces are hereby authorized to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest as may be necessary for security purposes.

3. The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned land forming part of Plot No. 27 of the Government Survey Plan No. II.35, situated at Leko Quarter of Rizokarpaso village, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings, Cyprus, dated 3rd October, 1956, and deposited in the Office of the Commissioner, Famagusta.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 13) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 13) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 26th November, 1955, I, Omer Faik Muftizade, Commissioner of Paphos, do hereby give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession of the land specified in the Schedule hereto as from 29th October, 1955, until further notice.

2. The use of the said land as an aerodrome by the Government of Cyprus and Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorised.

3. The Authority using the land in pursuance of this order is entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purpose of their occupation.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

5. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest in the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately-owned land situated in the village of Yeroskipos, comprising 68½ donums or thereabouts being parts of plots Nos. 57, 45, 41, 44, 122, 121, 120, 119, 117, 118/3/3, 118/3/1, 126/3/2, 126/3/1, 127/1 and

129.2 of the Government Survey Plan No. LI.19 and parts of plots Nos. 88/2, 89, 90, 80/3/1, 80/3/2 and 79 of the Government Survey Plan No. LI.20, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked "Yeroskipos Aerodrome" signed by the Director of Public Works and dated the 22nd February, 1956, a copy of which has been deposited in the Commissioner's Office at Paphos.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 14) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the above Regulations and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, hereby order that between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1.30 p.m. daily until further notice within the area described in the Schedule hereto—

- (a) no bus or lorry shall circulate or be left stationary on any public street, including sidewalks; and
- (b) no goods carrying trailer shall circulate or be left stationary on any public street without a permit first obtained from the Commissioner.

SCHEDULE.

The area bounded on the east by Avgoustas Theodoras street and Zenonos street (inclusive), on the north by Gladstone street and Navarino street (exclusive) on the west by Eleftheria street and Victoria street (inclusive) and on the south by Spyros Araouzos street and Christodoulou Haggipavlou street (inclusive): Provided that entry to the parking area lying to the south of the Ay. Napa Church along Kommandaria street shall be permitted.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the above Regulations and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, hereby order as follows:—

Until further notice the one-way section of the sea front at Limassol from the corner of Commandaria street along Spyros Araouzos street and Christodoulou Haggipavlou street to the corner of Kriti street shall cease to be a one-way street.
