**THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL,
1939 AND 1956.**

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Officers' Protection) Regulations, 1956.

2. No prosecution shall be instituted in any Court in Cyprus established by or under any Order of Her Majesty in Council or any Cyprus Law without the leave of the Attorney-General against any Police Officer or against any member of Her Majesty's Forces or against any public officer in respect of any offence alleged to have been committed by any such person while acting or purporting to act in the course of his duties.

3. In these Regulations—

“member of Her Majesty's Forces” includes persons who are War Department Auxiliary Policemen or Royal Air Force Auxiliary Policemen when acting in the course of their duties as such;

“Police Officer” means any member of the Cyprus Police Force and includes every other person lawfully authorised to discharge police duties;

“public officer” means a person holding or acting in any office in the service of the Crown, in a civil capacity in respect of the Government of Cyprus.
