**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 16) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38A.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 38A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 16) 1956, the Governor's Deputy considering it necessary in the public interest so to do, has been pleased to declare the area described in the first column of the Schedule hereto, excluding the areas described in the second column of the said Schedule, to be a danger area.

The limits and extent of the aforesaid area shall be demarcated by notices in English, Greek and Turkish put up at the point where each road or recognized track enters the area and on any prominent and accessible feature lying in the boundaries of the aforesaid area.

2. This Order may be cited as the Danger Areas (Limassol District No. 1) Order, 1956, and shall come into force on the 1st December, 1956.

SCHEDULE.

<i>Area</i> : All that area within 300 yards on either side of the main road from Limassol to Polemidhia Military Camp starting from, but excluding, the Ayios Georghios Monastery and ending at the Polemidhia Military Camp perimeter.	<i>(i) Road</i> : The main road from Limassol to Polemidhia Military Camp. <i>(ii) Village</i> : That part of the village boundary of Berengaria village which abuts on the danger area.
