DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 3B.

By virtue of my appointment as Controller of Petroleum, I hereby direct that as from the 10th day of December, 1956, the quantities of motor spirit for which each type of coupon shall be valid will be as follows :—

Type A	—	6 gallons
B	—	6 gallons
C	—	4 gallons
D	—	3 gallons
E	—	2 gallons
F	—	1 gallon
G	—	$\frac{1}{2}$ gallon.

THE PETROLEUM (RESTRICTIONS) ORDER, 1956.

DIRECTION No. 1 UNDER SECTION 3B.

With effect from the 10th day of December, 1956, no person shall purchase or procure any motor spirit except from an authorized retailer and upon the surrender to such authorized retailer of a valid official purchase coupon or coupons issued by the Controller. The quantity purchased must not exceed the quantity for which the coupon or coupons are valid.
