THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Extension of Period of Duration of Municipal Councils) Regulations, 1956.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Municipal Corporations Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") the period of duration of every council of a municipal corporation which is in existence on the date on which these Regulations are made is hereby extended for a period of one year from the date on which such period of duration would have expired save for the provisions of these Regulations, and the operation of those provisions of the Law which relate to the election of councillors is hereby suspended accordingly.
- 3. Section 11 of the Law shall accordingly be read and construed as if for the words "four years", occurring in line 1 thereof, and in line 3 of paragraph (b) of the proviso thereto, there were substituted the words "five years".
