THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 16th September, 1955, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 17th September, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), the Governor had authorized the use for air force purposes of certain lands at locality "Trapeza" within the village of Pano Kividhes in the District of Limassol, as set out in the Second Schedule to the Order (hereinafter referred to as "the lands"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months :

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the lands should continue to be used for air force purposes for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the Order :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorisation for using the lands for air force purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the ~~15th February~~ *16th March*, 1956, and the Order is so extended accordingly.

## THE WELLS LAW.

CAP. 312 AND LAWS 19 OF 1951 AND 42 OF 1953.

ORDER BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 3A.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3A of the Wells Law, His Excellency the Governor hereby defines for the purposes of the said section the areas set out in the Schedule hereto as areas in which no permit for the sinking or construction of a well shall be issued by the Commissioner and no variation or modification of any condition or restriction imposed on any such permit shall be effected, save with the concurrence of the Director of Water Development, in accordance with the provisions of the said section.
