(b) the person for the time being holding the office of Senior Specialist (Surgeon), for cases falling under general surgery; and

(c) the person for the time being holding the office of Senior Specialist

(Orthopaedic Surgeon), for cases of an orthopaedic nature.
2. The appointments made under Notification No. 72 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 4th February, 1954, and under Notification No. 464 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 4th August, 1955, are hereby revoked.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

Whereas it has been represented to the Governor that it is desirable in the public interest to acquire certain lands situated at Knodhara in the District of Famagusta for the purpose of erecting thereon a Moslem Secondary School (Orta Okul):

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Governor hereby declares the acquisition of the said lands for the aforesaid purpose to be an undertaking of public utility and does hereby authorise the carrying out of the said undertaking and hereby entrusts the Governing Body for the Moslem Secondary Schools, Famagusta, with the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking, the cost whereof shall be borne by the Governing Body hereinbefore mentioned.
