In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia and Kyrenia District No. 5) Order, 1956.
- 2. No person within the village boundaries of Pano and Kato Zodhia shall be out of doors on the dates and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Assistant Commissioner of Lefka, or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of March, 1956.

No person within the area of the village boundaries of the villages of Kato Pyrgos, Morphou and Evrykhou shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia, or the Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of March, 1956.
