Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of March, 1956.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Famagusta District No. 2) Order, 1956.

No person within the area of the Municipal boundaries of Famagusta, excluding the Old City, shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Famagusta, or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of March, 1956.
