THE POST OFFICE LAW. CAP. 281 AND LAW 44 OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2829 MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Post Office Cap. 281 Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, 44 of 1953 has been pleased to order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Parcels Post Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Post Office Gazettes: (Parcels Post Rates of Postage) Order, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as Suppl. No. 3: "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together. 22.7.1955. "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Parcels Post Rates of Postage) Orders, 1955 and 1956.

- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entry relating to the country shown in the Schedule hereto and the substitution therefor of the entry relating to the same country set out in the Schedule hereto.
  - 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1956.
