## THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 9) Order, 1956.
- 2. No person within the area of the moat and entrances crossing the area between the city wall and the Ring Road (but not including the Ring Road) the Ring Road comprising the following streets, avenues and squares:—

Municipal Forest Avenue, Themis Street, Salamis Street, Stasinos Street, Homer Avenue, Lloyd George Square, Egypt Street, Stanley Casson Square, King Edward VII Avenue, Railway Street and Kaimakli Street,

shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 31st day of March, 1956.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 4) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34 (1) (b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, hereby prohibit the use of motor cycles and bicycles within the municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa from 4 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Sunday the 1st April, 1956.

2. This Order is in addition to the Order made by me on 5th March, 1956, published in *Gazette* Supplement No. 3 of 6th March, 1956, which still continues in force.
