REGULATIONS MADE BY THE WATER BOARD OF FAMAGUSTA UNDER SECTION 38.

20 of 1951 21 of 1952 52 of 1954. In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 38 of the Water Supply (Municipal and other Areas) Laws, 1951 to 1954, the Water Board of Famagusta hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Famagusta Water Board (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Famagusta Water Board Regulations, 1952 and 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Famagusta Water Board Regulations, 1952 and 1956.
- 2. The following regulation shall be inserted immediately after regulation 13:—
 - "13A. Any consumer may apply to the Board for the testing of the water meter installed at his premises on payment to the Board of the sum of £0.500 mils:

Provided that, if after testing, it is found that such meter does not operate properly, the sum of £0.500 mils will be refunded to such consumer."

The above Regulations have been approved by the Governor. (M.P. 1436/51/3.)
