THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 6) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 40.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 40 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 6) 1956, I, William Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, do hereby order that all establishments owned by Greek Cypriots, and situated within the Municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa shall be closed, and shall remain closed between the hours of 7 a.m. on the 18th April, 1956, and 7 a.m. on the 25th April, 1956, inclusive:

Provided that hotels may remain open for the purposes of catering for residents staying therein.

The Order published under Notification No. 313 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th April, 1956, is hereby revoked.
