ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 3.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (COLLECTIVE PUNISHMENT) REGULATIONS, 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 3 (iii).

I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 3 of the Emergency Powers (Collective Punishment), Regulations, 1955, and with the approval of the Governor, do hereby order the seizure of the immovable property in the village of Kalopsidha shown in red on the tracing from sheet XXXII/22 of the Government Survey Plan dated 13th April and signed by me, which property is more particularly described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

- 1. The wall, sixty-two feet or thereabouts in length, standing on the southern boundary of plot 180, registered in the name of Lambros Kyriacou.
- 2. All immovable property, as defined in section 2 of the Immovable property (Tenure, Registration and Valuation) Law, Cap. 231, comprised by, erected on or above, or appertaining to that part of plot 187, 187/3 and 190/2/2/3 registered in the name of Hadji Loizis Panayi Yeorghi, with a frontage on the main Nicosia–Famagusta road of fifty-three feet or thereabouts from the boundary of plot 188 and a width of twelve feet or thereabouts measured from the boundary of the road up to but not including the arches supporting the ridge of the building standing thereon.
- 3. The wall, eighteen feet or thereabouts in length standing on the boundary between the main Nicosia-Famagusta Road and plot 188 registered in the name of Tryphonou Chrysou Lefteri.
