THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAW, 1952.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 20.

13 of 1952. In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 20 of the Aliens and Immigration Law, 1952, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

S.L. Vol. I. p. 41. 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after Regulation 6, of the following regulation :—

" 6A. Notwithstanding anything contained in these regulations a registration officer may at any time call upon any alien resident within his district to furnish such registration officer with three copies of a photograph representing a true likeness of himself not larger than two inches wide by three inches long."

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order that the notice under sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law made by the Governor and published under Notification No. 68 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th February, 1952, be amended by the deletion therefrom of the words " Civil Aviation Officer " (lines 12 and 13) and the substitution therefor of the words " Director of Civil Aviation ".
