THE DIPLOMATIC PRIVILEGES (EXTENSION) LAW.

CAP. 202 AND LAW II OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2833

MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Diplomatic Privileges (Extension) Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (World Health Organization) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Diplomatic Privileges (World Health Organization) Order, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (World Health Organization) Orders, 1949 and 1956.

2.—(i) The principal Order shall have effect as if in Article 9 thereof references to representatives of member Governments included references to representatives of the Governments of Associate Members of the Organization.

(ii) For the purposes of this Order, the expression "representatives of the Governments of Associate Members of the Organization" shall be deemed to include their official staffs, accompanying them as such representatives, as delegates, deputy delegates, advisers, technical experts or secretaries of delegations.
