THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. Laws 17 and 47 of 1955.

Order made under Section 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Paphos District No. 9) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Paphos or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 25th day of April, 1956.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The whole area of the town of Ktima including Kato Paphos, with the exception of the following area, that is to say, from the sea at the mouth of "Diplarkaki" River and along it up to "Diplarkaki" Bridge crossing Khloraka Road; thence southwards along Khloraka Road, Fellahoghlou Street and Thermopylae Street; thence to the most southern point of Djami Djedid; thence in a south-westerly direction to the cape west of Paleo-kastra locality; thence along the sea-shore to the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 20.30 hrs. on the 25th April, 1956, until further notice.
