

by the Authority for the purpose of its functions, that is to say, for the purpose of erecting a sub-station, a stand-by station, workshop and stores ;

And whereas the Authority has, at the expiration of the period set out in the notice, forwarded to the Governor a plan of the immovable property, together with the particulars required to be furnished under section 27 (2) of the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 to 1954, and the objections or statements made against the proposed acquisition ;

And whereas His Excellency the Governor has approved the plan submitted and has considered it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the immovable property in question be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 27 (3) of the Electricity Development Laws, 1952 to 1954, His Excellency the Governor does hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the said Laws, of the immovable property.
