**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 7) 1956.**

**ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 30 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 30 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 7) 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Control of Navigation) (No. 2) Order, 1956.

2. No vessel shall enter, or be within, the area of the territorial waters of the Colony specified in the Schedule hereto provided that this Order shall not apply to vessels entering or leaving the area for the purposes of or in connection with mining operations by the Cyprus Mines Corporation at Karavostasi and the Cyprus Sulphur and Copper Co. Ltd., at Limni.

**SCHEDULE.**

The territorial waters of Cyprus contained within a line drawn 360° to the high seas from Karavostasi and a line drawn 360° to the high seas from Latchi on Admiralty Chart No. 2074 dated the 15th October, 1954.
