2. In the first line of clause 3 (1) of the principal Order the words "Commerce and Industry" shall be substituted for the word "Agriculture".

3. This Order shall come into operation as from the first day of February, 1956.

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW. CAP. 39 AND LAW 50 OF 1954.

## ORDER UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :----

1. The First Schedule to the Law shall be amended as follows :---

(i) In Class I (i) shall be added the word "Tangerines";

(ii) In Class V (i) shall be added the words "Hemp" "Origanum";

(iii) In Class VII (i) shall be added the words " Other nuts " ;

(iv) In Class IX, after the word "Carobs" shall be added the words " and carob products ".

2. This order shall come into effect on the 1st day of February, 1956.
