

No. 439. THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW.

CAP. 222 AND LAW 23 OF 1951.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 2.

Whereas in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, His Excellency the Governor by notice published under Notification No. 221 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 30th April, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Notification") had declared the area set out in the Schedule thereto to be a Bombardment Range Area for the purposes of the aforesaid Law for a period of twelve months from the 23rd day of April, 1953, the date of the principal Notification, which period was later extended till the 31st day of May, 1956, by Notification No. 357 dated the 31st May, 1954, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 3rd June, 1954, and by Notification No. 284 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 5th May, 1955:

And whereas it is desirable that the period of the principal Notification should be further extended till the 31st day of May, 1957:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that the principal Notification shall be in full force and effect for a further period of twelve months commencing on the 1st day of June, 1956, and ending on the 31st day of May, 1957.
