

No. 45. THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW.  
CAP. 39 AND LAW 50 OF 1954.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Export) (Declaration) Order, 1956.

2. The provisions of the Law shall apply to the export to all countries of the agricultural produce mentioned in the First Schedule hereto :

Provided that the Director may at his discretion at any time by Notice published in the *Gazette* suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months the application of the provisions of the Law to any produce other than produce to which the provisions of the Law were applied before the date of the making of this Order.

3. The Agricultural Produce (Export) (Declaration) Order, 1953, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder. *Gazette : Suppl. No. 3: 16.7.1953.*

**THE ADULTERATION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE  
LAW, 1954.**

**REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 13.**

In exercise of the powers vested in him under section 13 of the Adulteration of Agricultural Produce Law, 1954, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Adulteration of Agricultural Produce (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Adulteration of Agricultural Produce Regulations, 1955, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Adulteration of Agricultural Produce Regulations, 1955 and 1956.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by :—

- (1) The deletion from regulation 3 of the principal Regulations of the phrase "for export, or preparation for export from the Colony".  
(2) The deletion of the word "export" appearing in regulations 4 and 5 of the principal Regulations.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by :—

- (1) The deletion of the words "export and" appearing in the third column of the Schedule thereto.
