No. 45. THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW. CAP. 39 AND LAW 50 OF 1954.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Agricultural Cap. 39 Produce (Export) Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") His ⁵⁰ of 1954. Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :-

1. This Order may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Export) (Declaration) Order, 1956.

2. The provisions of the Law shall apply to the export to all countries of the agricultural produce mentioned in the First Schedule hereto :

Provided that the Director may at his discretion at any time by Notice published in the *Gazette* suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months the application of the provisions of the Law to any produce other than produce to which the provisions of the Law were applied before the date of the making of this Order.

3. The Agricultural Produce (Export) (Declaration) Order, 1953, Gazette: is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done or left undone Suppl. No. 3: 16.7.1953, Suppl. No. 3: thereunder.
