THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955. LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Kyrenia District No. 22K) Order, 1956.
- 2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Kyrenia or the Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 28th day of May, 1956.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 7) 1956.

Order made under Regulation 34 (1) (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph 34(1)(b) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955, to (No. 7) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd December, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, hereby prohibit the use of all motor vehicles, motor cycles and bicycles within the Municipal limits of Famagusta between the hours of 7.30 p.m. and 12 midnight as from today, the 25th May, 1956, and until further notice:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to motor vehicles used in loading and unloading operations at the Port, the drivers of which have obtained a permit from the Assistant Commissioner of Police.

The Order published under Notification No. 387 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 10th May, 1956, is hereby cancelled.
