THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 7) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 7) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. Her Majesty's Forces are hereby authorized to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest as may be necessary for security purposes.

3. The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

1. All canes and other vegetation standing between the main Famagusta-Larnaca road and plot 139/1, sheet 33/19W of the Government Survey Plan, together with the fence preventing access to the plot from the road.

2. All land in plot 143, sheet 33/19W of the Government Survey Plan, within 12 feet of the main Famagusta-Larnaca road as formerly aligned.

3. All canes and other vegetation between the main Famagusta-Larnaca road and the fruit trees in plots 279, 280, 341 and 467, Block B, Ayios Loukas Quarter, together with the fences preventing access to plots 279, 280 and 467 from the road.

4. The hedge and fence preventing access to plot 392, Block B, Ayios Loukas Quarter, from the main Famagusta-Larnaca road.
