THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 30 (1) AND 69.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 30 (1) and 69 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby revoke the Emergency Powers (Control of Navigation) (No. 2) Order, 1956,* without prejudice to anything done thereunder.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

DIRECTION GIVEN UNDER REGULATION 60.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 60 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8), 1956, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby direct as follows:—

Every person who has been appointed to serve as mukhtar or aza of any village or quarter under the provisions of the Village Authorities Law and who is holding office on the date of this direction shall perform the duties which are imposed on him under the provisions of any Law or public instrument in force for the time being, and shall not cease to perform such duties without the consent in writing of the Governor.
