## REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

G. E. SINCLAIR,

Governor's Deputy.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby make the following Regulations:-

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Transfer of Cases to the Special Court) Regulations, 1956.
- (2) The Interpretation Law shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations and of any direction given thereunder, as it applies to the interpretation of a Law and, for the purposes of the said Law, these Regulations shall be deemed to be Laws.
- 2. Without prejudice to any other powers conferred by any other Law and notwithstanding anything in any other Law contained, where any criminal proceedings have been instituted in any Court by or on behalf of any person in respect of any offence which is a specified offence for the purposes of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1956, or of any Law amending or substituted for the same, the Chief Justice may, at any time and at any stage of the proceedings, either with or without application made by or on behalf of the Attorney-General or by any interested party, direct the transfer of the case to the Special Court, and any case so transferred shall be tried and determined by the Special Court.
