THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 63A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 63A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, I, the Commissioner of Limassol, do hereby prohibit the sounding of sirens, hooters or any form of sound signal within the municipal area of Limassol.

I further order that an "alarm signal" and an "all-clear signal" shall be in force within the municipal area of Limassol and direct that the following steps shall be taken upon the sounding of the said signals:—

Upon the sounding of the "alarm signal":

- (a) all vehicles shall be drawn to the side of the road and remain stationary until the sounding of the "all-clear signal"; and
- (b) all pedestrians shall stand clear of the streets and pavements as far as is reasonably possible for them to do so and shall not walk about until the sounding of the "all-clear signal".

This Order shall come into effect as from the 9th June, 1956.

THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 618 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th October, 1955, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 18) Order, 1956.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 30th day of May, 1956.
