THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38 (1).

I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Larnaca District No. 2) Order, 1956.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955.

SCHEDULE I.

Plot 308 and parts of plots 301, 307 and 361 of Government Plan, Sheet XLI.57.1.1 at Larnaca and the seashore and foreshore adjoining as delineated in red on the plan dated 18th June, 1956, and signed by the Commissioner of Larnaca ; also all that area of Cyprus territorial waters within a distance of 50 yards from low water mark on the aforesaid seashore.

SCHEDULE II.

The jetty adjoining the aforesaid plot 307 and all that area of Cyprus territorial waters within a distance of 50 yards of it.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)  
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 8) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 40.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 40 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, I, the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, do hereby order that all establishments as defined in the Schedule hereto within the Rural Municipal limits of Karavas shall be closed and shall remain closed until further notice.

This Order shall come into effect as from the 8th June, 1956.

SCHEDULE.

Cinematograph theatres, theatres, cabarets, clubs, bars, restaurants, coffee-shops, bars in hotels, restaurants in hotels and any other place or premises of public resort or entertainment whatsoever.
