## THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

Bye-laws made by the Improvement Board of Lyso.
In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages 12 of 1950 (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement 18 of 1950 Board of Lyso hereby make the following bye-laws :-

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso Bye-laws, 195I and 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Lyso Bye-laws, 1951 to 1956.

2. Bye-law 26 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :-
(1) By the deletion therefrom of the figures $2 /-, 3 /-, 1 /-,-/ 4 \frac{1}{2},-/ 6,1 /-$ and $2 /$ - appearing opposite items $(a)$ to $(g)$, both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 100 mils , 150 mils, 50 mils, 25 mils, 33 mils, 50 mils and 100 mils respectively.

(e) When the value of such goods exceeds 750 mils but does not exceed $f_{1}, 000$
(f) When the value of such goods exceeds $£ 1.000$ but does not exceed $f_{2} 2.000$. .. .. .. .. 50
(g) When the value of such goods exceeds $£ 2.000$ but does not exceed $£_{4} 4000$.. .. .. .. 100
(2) If the value of such goods exceeds $£_{4} .000$, a fee of 50 mils for each additional pound or fraction thereof shall be added to the aforementioned fee of 100 mils."
4. Bye-law 51 (r) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $-/ 6,-/ 4 \frac{1}{2}, \mathrm{I} /-\mathrm{I} / 4 \frac{1}{2}$ and $2 /$-appearing opposite items (a) to (e), both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 33 mils, 25 mils, 50 mils, 75 mils, and 100 mils, respectively.
5. Bye-law 58 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $1 /-, 1 / 3$ and $2 /-$ appearing opposite items $(a),(b)$ and $(c)$ and the substitution therefor of the figures and words $50^{\circ}$ mils, 67 mils and 100 mils respectively.
6. Bye-law 65 (1) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Notification No. 132, Gazette Supplement No. 3 of 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure " $1 p$." (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 5 mils ".
7. Bye-law 75 (I) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $2 /-, 2 /-, 1 /-, 2 /-,-/ 6,-/ 3,-/ 2,-12$ and $-/ 3$ appearing opposite items $(a)$ to $(i)$, both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 100 mils, 100 mils, 50 mils, 100 mils, 33 mils, 18 mils, Io mils, 10 mils and 18 mils respécectively.
8. Bye-law 8I (I) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby" amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two to forty shillings " (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words " 100 mils to $£ 2.000$ mils."
9. Bye-law 82 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion from items $(a),(b),(c)$ and $(d)$ thereof of the figures $2 /-, 1 /-,-/ 6$ and $1 p$. to 20s. and the substitution therefor of the figures and words $100 \mathrm{mils}, 50 \mathrm{mils}$, 33 mils and 5 mils to $f 1.000$ respectively.
ro. Bye-law 9r (2) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two piastres" (line 3) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 10 mils".

I I. Bye-law ino (4) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "ten shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 500 mils ".
12. Bye-law 117 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion from sub-paragraphs $(a)$ and (b) thereof of the figures $£ 3$ and $£ 10$ (line 2 in both cases) and the substitution therefor of the figures $£ 3.000$ and £10.000 respectively.
13. Bye-law 135 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words " ten shillings," (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 500 mils".
14. Bye-law 136 (2) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "ten shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 500 mils".
15. Bye-law I39 (3) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words " one shilling" and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 50 mils ".
16. Bye-law 155 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $-/ 4,-/ 6,1 /-$ and $2 /-$ appearing opposite sub-paragraphs $(a),(b),(c)$ and $(d)$ and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 23 mils, 33 mils, 50 mils and 100 mils respectively.
17. Bye-law 160 (I) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor :-
" 160.-(1) The following charges shall be paid by every person posting or exhibiting any advertisement or notice on any hoarding, that is to say :-

Bye-law 171 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Notification No. 132 to the Gazette of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures and words " 6 piastres" and " 4 piastres" (lines 3 and 4) respectively and the substitution therefor of the figures and words " 33 mils" and " 23 mils" respectively.
19. Bye-law 178 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :-
(I) By the deletion therefrom of the words " two paras per oke in respect "thereof" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words " 5 mils for every 20 okes or part thereof".
(2) By the deletion of the provisos thereto.
20. Bye-law 179 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Notification No. 175, Gazette Supplement No. 3 of 17 th March, 1955) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "six piastres" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word " 33 mils".

* 2I. Bye-law 18I (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :-

 250 mils, 500 mils, $£_{2} .000, £_{2} .000, £^{2} .000$ and $£_{2} .000$ " respectively.
23. The Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :-

Provided that-
(a) Fractions under 2 mils shall not be collected;

Provided also that the minimum fee for any one weighing or measuring or testing shall be 5 mils."
