Whereas by Orders dated 7th, 9th, 21st and 28th January, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazettes of 10th and 26th January and 2nd February, 1956, under Notification Nos. 15, 16, 59 and 72 respectively (hereinafter referred to as "the Orders") His Excellency the Governor had authorized the use for military purposes of the lands and properties set out in the Second Schedule to the Orders (hereinafter referred to as "the lands") subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months as from the dates thereof:

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the lands should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the orders:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1955), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that the aforesaid authorizations for using the lands for military purposes be continued for a further period of six months from the date of the expiration of the Orders, subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Orders, and the Orders are hereby extended accordingly.
