

Fees shall be calculated on the actual weight of the goods weighed at the above rates :

Provided that—

- (a) fractions under 2 mils shall not be collected ;
- (b) for fractions of 2 mils and over and under 4 mils the sum of 3 mils shall be collected ;
- (c) for fractions of 4 mils and over and under 5 mils the sum of 5 mils shall be collected :

Provided also that the minimum fee for any one weighing, measuring or testing shall be 5 mils ”.

THE VILLAGES (ADMINISTRATION AND IMPROVEMENT) LAWS, 1950 AND 1953.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE IMPROVEMENT BOARD OF YEROSKIPOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 24 of the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Improvement Board of Yeroskipos hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos Bye-laws, 1951 and 1955 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Bye-laws ”) and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Yeroskipos Bye-laws, 1951 to 1956.

2. Bye-law 26 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :—

(i) By the deletion therefrom of the figures 1/-, 1/4½, -/6, -/4½, -/4½, -/6, 1/- and 1/4½ appearing opposite items (a) to (h), both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 50 mils, 75 mils, 33 mils, 25 mils, 25 mils, 33 mils, 50 mils and 75 mils respectively.

(ii) By the deletion from the proviso thereto of the words “ one shilling ” (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word “ 50 mils ”.

3. Bye-law 37 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor :—

“ Bye-law 37.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any perishable goods in the market of perishable goods, that is to say :—

	<i>Mils.</i>
(a) When the value of such goods is under 100 mils ..	10
(b) When the value of such goods exceeds 100 mils but does not exceed 200 mils	18
(c) When the value of such goods exceeds 200 mils but does not exceed 400 mils	23
(d) When the value of such goods exceeds 400 mils but does not exceed 750 mils	28
(e) When the value of such goods exceeds 750 mils but does not exceed £1.000	33
(f) When the value of such goods exceeds £1.000 but does not exceed £2.000	50
(g) When the value of such goods exceeds £2.000 but does not exceed £4.000	100

(2) If the value of such goods exceeds £4.000 mils a fee of 10 mils for each additional pound or fraction thereof shall be added to the aforementioned fee of 100 mils. For perishable goods sold under a permit from the Inspector at any place other than the market of perishable goods, a fee of 5 mils for every 20 okes or part thereof shall be paid.”

4. Bye-law 51 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $-\frac{1}{6}$, $-\frac{1}{4\frac{1}{2}}$, $1/-$, $1/4\frac{1}{2}$ and $2/-$ appearing opposite sub-paragraphs (a) to (e), both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 33 mils, 25 mils, 50 mils, 75 mils and 100 mils respectively.

5. Bye-law 58 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $1/-$, $1/4\frac{1}{2}$ and $2/-$ appearing opposite items (a), (b) and (c) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 50 mils, 75 mils and 100 mils respectively.

6. Bye-law 65 (1) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure " $1p$." (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "5 mils".

7. Bye-law 75 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $1/-$, $1/-$, $-\frac{1}{3}$, $-\frac{1}{3}$, $-\frac{1}{1}$, $-\frac{1}{1}$ and $-\frac{1}{2}$ appearing opposite items (a) to (g), both inclusive, and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 50 mils, 50 mils, 18 mils, 18 mils, 5 mils, 5 mils and 10 mils respectively.

8. Bye-law 81 (1) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two to forty shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words "100 mils to £2.000".

9. Bye-law 82 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion from items (a), (b), (c) and (d) thereof of the figures $2/-$, $1/-$, $-\frac{1}{3}$ and $1p$. to 20s. and the substitution therefor of the figures and words 100 mils, 50 mils, 18 mils, and 5 mils to £1.000 respectively.

10. Bye-law 91 (2) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the model Bye-laws published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1951) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two piastres" (line 3) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "10 mils".

11. Bye-law 110 (4) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure " $5s$." (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "250 mils".

12. Bye-law 117 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) By the deletion from sub-paragraph (a) thereof of the words "thirty shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "£1.500 mils".

(2) By the deletion from sub-paragraph (b) thereof of the figure £3 (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "£3.000 mils".

(3) By the deletion from the proviso to sub-paragraph (b) thereof of the words "three shillings" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "150 mils".

13. Bye-law 135 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "ten shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "500 mils".

14. Bye-law 136 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "five shillings" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "250 mils".

15. Bye-law 139 (3) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "two shillings" and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "100 mils".

16. Bye-law 155 (2) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figures $-\frac{1}{2}$, $-\frac{1}{3}$, $-\frac{1}{5}$, and $1/-$ appearing opposite sub-paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) and by the substitution therefor of the figures and words 10 mils, 18 mils, 28 mils and 50 mils respectively.

17. Bye-law 160 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following Bye-law substituted therefor :—

“ Bye-law 160.—(1) The following charges shall be paid by every person posting or exhibiting any advertisement or notice on any hoarding, that is to say :—

18. Bye-law 171 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “ three piastres ” and “ two piastres ” (lines 3 and 4) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words “ 18 mils ” and “ 10 mils ” respectively.

19. Bye-law 178 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) By the deletion therefrom of the words “ two paras per oke in respect thereof ” (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the figures and words “ 5 mils for every 20 okes or part thereof ”.

(2) By the deletion of the provisos thereto.

20. Bye-law 179 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the figure and word “ 4½ piastres ” (line 3) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word “ 25 mils ”.

21. Bye-law 185 (1) of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in Notification No. 329, *Gazette* Supplement No. 3 of the 26th May, 1955) is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “ An annual fee not exceeding : shillings ” (line 4) and of the figures “ 10/-, 60/-, 20/-, 20/-, 5/-, 10/-, 20/-, 20/-, 200/- and 100/- ” opposite items (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), and (j) respectively and the substitution therefor of the words “ An annual fee not exceeding : Mils ” and of the figures and words 500 mils, £3,000, £1,000, £1,000, 250 mils, 500 mils, £1,000, £1,000, £10,000 and £5,000 respectively.

22. The Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—
