ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATIONS 3/AND 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulations 3 and 4 of the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Registration

Areas) Order, 1956.

2. The area of each District in the Colony is hereby declared to be a registration area for the purposes of the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"), and each such registration area shall be known by the name specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. Subject to the provisions of Regulation 26 of the Regulations, all persons in every registration area are hereby directed to register with any Registration Officer within a period of two months from the 8th August, 1956.

4. Subject to the provisions of Regulation 27 of the Regulations, the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (Troodos Sub-Area) (No. 2) Order, 1956, and the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (Troodos Sub-Area) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order, 1956, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 60 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 8) 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby direct as follows:—

- 1. Every person who has been appointed to serve as Mukhtar or Aza of any village or quarter under the provisions of the Village Authorities Law and who is holding office on the date of this direction shall perform the duties of Authenticating Officers for the purposes of the Emergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956, and shall, when called upon, assist the registration officers in their village or quarter in identifying persons who come up for registration and in giving the registration officers all necessary help for the said purpose.
- 2. Authenticating Officers shall be paid the sum of £1.000 for each day of work provided that where they work for less than 4 hours a day their remuneration shall be £0.500 mils.
