THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (20. 10) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 34.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under Regulation 34 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 10) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 807 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 27th December, 1955, I, Reginald Norman Kershaw Beresford, the Commissioner of Nicosia, do hereby prohibit until further notice :—

- (i) The use of all motor vehicles, motor cycles and pedal cycles within the Municipal limits of Nicosia and the village areas of Strovolos, Engomi, Ayios Dhometios, Trakhonas, Omorphita, Beuyuk Kaimakli and Palouriotissa as from 04.00 hours on Tuesday the 7th day of August, 1956, until further notice :
 - Provided that this part of this Order shall not apply to :--
 - (a) the holders of official Curfew Passes on duty issued by the Commissioner of Nicosia or by the Assistant Commissioner of Police of the Nicosia Division;
 - (b) persons of non-Cypriot origin subject to the production on demand of a passport proving that they are of non-Cypriot origin;
 - (c) public omnibuses, lorries and vans engaged on legitimate commerce or trade;
 - (d) members of Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Government Service when in uniform and the Cyprus Police Force when on duty.
- (ii) The parking or leaving of pedal cycles or motor cycles in or on the public roads within the areas defined above during the continuance of this Order.

The Prohibition of Parking of Vehicles (Nicosia No. 1) Order, 1956 (published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 30th May, 1956) shall, in so far as it is consistent with the provisions of this Order, be in full force and operation.
