ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 24)

Order, 1956.

2. No person within the village boundaries of Pano Platres shall be out of doors on the date and during the hours prescribed in the Schedule hereto except under the written authority of the Commissioner of Limassol, or the Senior Superintendent of Police, Limassol:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive
