THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 10) 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 62A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 62A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 10) 1956, I, the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Swimming (Kyrenia District No. 1) Order, 1956.

2. As from today no person shall swim within the area specified in the Schedule hereto, except under the written authority of the Superintendent of Police, Kyrenia.
