THE EMERGENCY LAWS (TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 40.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 40, as Gazette: set out in the Schedule to the Emergency Laws (Transitional Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues to be in force by virtue of the 8.12.1955. Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1955, His Excellency the Governor by this Order declares that the area set out in the Schedule hereto shall, until further Order, be a protected place for the purpose of the said Regulations and that, save with the permission under the hand of the Air Officer Commanding, Royal Air Force, Levant, or any officer authorized by him in that behalf and, subject to such directions as may be contained in the permission, no person shall be in such place.

2. A copy of this Order shall be posted on Notice Boards placed at or near the areas affected thereby.

## SCHEDULE.

All that area known as the "Tymbou Airfield", situated within Blocks D. E and F of Tymbou village and Blocks F and G of Palekythro village, Nicosia District, more particularly defined as the area delineated in green on the plan signed by the Squadron Leader Organization, H.Q. Royal Air Force, Levant, and dated the 24th September, 1956, a copy of which has been deposited in the Office of the Commissioner, Nicosia.
