REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 23.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Juvenile Offenders Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following regulations:—

page 1.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Juvenile Offenders (Amendment) Regulations, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Juvenile Offenders Regulations (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Paragraph (d) of regulation 37 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "three piastres" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "25 mils".
