## Order made under Section 40.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 40 of the said Regulations, I do hereby order as follows:—.

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Places of Public Resort

and Entertainment (Kyrenia District No. 28).

2. Every bar, cinematograph theatre, club, coffee-shop, confectioner's shop, restaurant, or any other place of public resort and entertainment within the area prescribed in the Schedule hereto shall be closed and remain closed until further notice except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia District.
