THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR/UNDER SECTION 6.

JOHN HARDING,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations :---

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Registration Gazette : Areas) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations, 1956 and shall be read as one with Supplement the Émergency Powers (Registration Areas) (No. 2) Regulations, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. Paragraph (1) of Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby Amendment 2. 4. Regulation 26 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the Amendment addition thereto of the following paragraph :---

"(f) any member of the visiting forces to which the Visiting Forces Gazette: (Application of Law) Order, 1956, applies, when stationed in Supplement Cyprus."
