**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 12) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in His Excellency the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 26th November, 1955, I, Warren Frederick Martin Clemens, Commissioner of Nicosia, do hereby give notice that in the interests of public order and safety and for maintaining supplies and services essential to the life of the Community, have taken possession with immediate effect of the land specified in the Schedule hereto for a period of three months from the date hereof.

2. The use of the said land as accommodation for members of the Prisons Staff is hereby authorized.

3. The authority using the land in pursuance of this Order is entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for the purposes of their occupation.

4. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

The privately owned land with all appurtenances thereto situate at Orta Keuy village and owned under Plot No. 436 (commonly known as Manor House School, Kermia) of Block F, Orta Keuy, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, dated 9th October, 1956, and deposited in his Office in Nicosia.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 12) 1956.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956, and delegated to me by Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I give notice that in the interests of public order and safety I have taken possession until further notice of the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. Her Majesty's Forces are hereby authorised to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest, as may be necessary for security purposes.

3. The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

SCHEDULE.

(a) All land, as defined in section 2 (i) of the aforesaid Regulations, within thirty yards of the Larnaca/Famagusta road in plots 206, 207, 188 and 189, Xylotymbou, of Sheet/Plan XLI/4.

(b) All land as defined in section 2 (i) of the aforesaid Regulations within ten yards of the Larnaca/Famagusta road in Plot 87 of Xylotymbou village Plan.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 39 (1).

I, the Assistant Commissioner of Kyrenia, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 39 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 12) 1956, do hereby order as follows:—

2. This Order may be cited as the Closing of Premises (Kyrenia District No. 2) Order, 1956.

3. That in the interest of public order, safety or defence, the premises described in the Schedule hereto shall be closed with effect from the 9th October, 1956, and remain closed until further notice.
