THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) (Amendment No. 1) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 17) 1956 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 1) 1957.

2. The following new Regulation shall be inserted immediately after Insertion of Regulation 39 of the principal Regulations:—

Regulation 39 of the principal Regulations

"Forfeiture and demolition of property, etc. 39A.—(1) The Commissioner of the District may by order made with the approval of the Governor direct the forfeiture of any building or other structure, whether permanent or temporary, and its contents, which he is satisfied is being used

Insertion of new Regulation 39A in the principal Regulations. by terrorists, and may by the same or subsequent order with the approval of the Governor direct the demolition of any such building or other structure and its contents.

(2) In this Regulation—

terrorist' means any person who—

(a) by the use of any firearm, ammunition or explosives, or of any arms, acts in a manner prejudicial to the public safety; or

(b) incites any person to the use of any firearm, ammuni-

tion or explosives, or of any arms; or
(c) carries or has in his possession or under his control
any firearm, ammunition or explosives, without
lawful excuse therefor.".

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 1) 1957.

## ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 39A.

Whereas, I, the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia, am satisfied that the building described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the building"), is a building which is being used by terrorists, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 39A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 1) 1957, with the approval of the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1: This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Forfeiture and Demolition) (Nicosia District) Order, 1957.
- 2. It is hereby directed that the building and its contents be forfeited and demolished.

## SCHEDULE.

The house standing on Plot No. 123 of Block "A", Ibrahim Pasha Quarter of Nicosia, of the Government Survey Plan, which is situated in the District of Nicosia.
