THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 4) 1957.

I, the Commissioner of Famagusta, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1957, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Famagusta District No. 16) Order, 1957.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 4) 1957.

3. This Order shall come into force at 0530 hours on Thursday 21st November, 1957, and shall remain in force until 1600 hours on Thursday, 21st November, 1957, unless revoked or extended by a supplementary order made under my hand.
